

## RUBY SAPPHIRE PORT CHECK LIST

Please have your Ruby POS manager ID and password ready at the time of installation. This is required to setup the mercury | One software.

If you don't have, please contact VeriFone Support Center for your store manager ID and password.

- 1. Push "Exit" on Ruby Register
- 2. Right click until you see "Maintenance"
- 3. Select "Maintenance"
- 4. Login with User ID and Password
- 5. Select "Print Install Information"
- 6. Report will print on the thermal printer as shown in image
- Look under "I/O Configuration" in the Printed Report for "SCAN.LDM"
- 8. If it is /dev/XXXX, look at the bottom of the printed report for upgrade Information
- 9. If it shows /dev/com8; your register is setup for scanner
